What is a Personal Representative – How Can Lake Elmo Bank Help?

A Personal Representative (or "PR") is the person or entity appointed to settle the estate of someone who passes away. (The term "Executor" is no longer used in Minnesota.). Often, the PR is a family member and is named in the Will. The PR is a fiduciary role. When assets are passed by Will, a PR is responsible for initiating and carrying out the probate proceeding through the courts.

There are varying duties required in a probate proceeding. The PR is responsible for these duties, which may include: creating an inventory of assets owned by the deceased person, securing those assets, providing notices to interested parties, preparing estate tax returns, paying expenses, distributing assets, and preparing the accountings and documents required to be filed with the probate court. In essence, the PR collects the assets held at the date of death and causes them to be distributed according to the deceased person's Will or the statutes of intestacy.

While being appointed PR in someone's Will is an honor, the probate proceeding and accounting requirements can be overwhelming. Lake Elmo Bank's Trust and Estate Services department can serve as Personal Representative or Co-PR when named in a Will.

Lake Elmo Bank is a professional fiduciary and has the expertise and experience that an individual may not have. Our team works closely with the family's attorney and tax preparer to settle the estate, but we are able to accomplish a lot of the work directly. This arrangement is efficient and often less expensive for the family.

Lake Elmo Bank can also be hired as an Agent to the Personal Representative. This arrangement allows Lake Elmo Bank to perform the duties of the Personal Representative, at the direction of the family member who maintains the decision-making power of the fiduciary role.
